Materials:

- » Super Bulky Weight yarn (size 6) 212 yards
2 skeins of Lion Brand Wool Ease Thick and Quick.
-or- 3 skeins of Loops and Threads Cozy Wool.
- » Crochet hook size Q (19.00 mm)
- » Large eye blunt needle

Finished Measurements:

- » 40" around (length of worked piece prior to seaming)
- » 14" tall

Abbreviations:

ch	chain
sc	single crochet
dc	double crochet
st(s)	stitches



Cowl:

» Ch 22.

» Row 1: Beginning in third chain from hook, work dc across. (20 sts)

» Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Work sc across row.

» Row 3: Ch 2, turn. Work dc across row.

» Repeat Rows 2-3 until you have 40" of length (or your desired length)

» Repeat Row 2 once more.

» Leaving enough length to seam with, cut yarn and pull end through.

Finishing:

» Using large eye blunt needle, sew seam to form cowl into a circle.

» Weave in all ends.

» Cut three lengths of yarn 46" each. (Or the length of your circumference plus 6").

» Knot ends of strands of yarn. Holding all three together, weave them through a 'row' of holes approx. 2" from the top of your cowl.

» Tie into bow at front. This is now an adjustable drawstring to 'gather' the cowl.
